4. Matters Arising

Rachael Ashton-Brown resigned shortly after the jubilee celebrations. The committee thank her for her work and wish her well.

Peter Edge also expressed his intention to resign with immediate effect. Other members are considering their position but none wished to become Chair. 5. Asthma Project.

Clive would like to continue to pursue this issue with Health representatives. He has contacted Alistair Gittings of Wilts Council and was given two other contacts, but no further progress has been made. Assistance from health professionals is needed to drill down into the parameters already identified and reported to the Area Board. Stephen Harris will see if this can be moved forward.

6. Issues identified from the JSA Event

Stephen reported that he is preparing an action plan/log based on the issues identified at this event and priorities set by the Area Board. These actions need someone or an organisation to take them on and drive them forward. The three themes chosen by the Area Board (AB) where Economy and Skills, Health & the Environment and Housing. One of the projects that Stephen had identified for the CAP to support and drive was the need for support and mentoring for managing small businesses. This could be linked with the Chamber of Commerce.

Stephen mentioned that work had already been achieved by the AB where they had supported a parish with a green space and community orchard which met the need for green spaces and wildlife corridors identified as an action for the Health and Environment theme.

Other work helping to connect the parishes and share information is taking place with the launch of a new website. The Just a Minute event at Dinton on September 5th is to publicise this.

7. Treasurers Report

In the treasurers absence - reported a balance of £5282:25 unchanged from the previous meeting.
